This scholarship is open to eligible students of color with financial need who desire to contribute to the advancement of racial and social justice for all.

Eligible applicants must be a graduating high school senior who resides in Bucks County.

Applicants must be applying to a four-year college or university program, a two-year associate degree program or to a trade school.

Financial need is strongly considered as part of the award process for this scholarship.

This year, three scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to deserving students.

NAACP Scholarships will be sent electronically or by mail. Electronic applications should be sent NAACPBucksEducation@gmail.com. Hard copies may be mailed to the Bucks County NAACP, P.O. Box 224, Bensalem, PA 19020.

Please submit all the required information together by the due date.

When complete, the application must be stamped **no later than March 15, 2026. All sections of the application must be completed as required and included in the application. Failure to include all requested information will invalidate the application.**

Recipients will be notified by **April 15, 2026**, of the application review results.

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SECTION E: LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION AND TRANSCRIPT SUBMISSION FOR THE STUDENT

Directions: You must submit **two letters of recommendation** with your application. These letters **should not** be written by relatives. One letter must be written by a teacher, counselor, or an administrator. The second letter may be written by a religious leader, a community representative or an employer.

The Bucks County Branch of the NAACP greatly appreciates your taking the time to write this letter of recommendation.

Your Letter of Recommendation should address the following information:

- How long and under what circumstances have you known the student.
- How would you rate this student's academic ability and his/her potential for success in college or in pursuit of a non-traditional degree?
- Describe the student's personality.
- Describe how the student demonstrates a commitment to community or public service and the impact of these actions on your school or community.
- Include any additional information you feel might assist the Bucks County Branch of the NAACP with evaluating this student.

Letters of recommendation should be mailed electronically by the person writing the letter. Official student transcripts must be submitted by the school.

The letters of recommendation and the official school transcript should be sent to NAACPBucksEducation@gmail.com. All attached electronic files must be named using the student's first and last name. (e.g. John.Smith.Recommendation.pdf or John.Smith.Transcript.pdf)

All letters of recommendation and transcripts must be received no later than March 15, 2026.
